What is Cascade Challenge?

Cascade Challenge is a primitive tent camping/outdoor skills competition weekend for Cadettes (Gr. 6-8) & Senior/Ambassador (Gr. 9-12) of Girl Scouts of Western Washington Council*. This event is sponsored by SU245 and brought to you by a GSWW Committee of Volunteers. This will be our 41st year! COVID-19 Considerations: We will be following Washington State/Public Health, GSWW, and Scouts BSA Guidelines.

Troops will Arrive Friday afternoon after 3PM to set up your campsite. Relax, look at the camp, mingle with other troops. All **challenge rotations** will take place on Saturday, where the scouts will be evaluated on their teamwork, leadership skills, and combined knowledge in the skill areas listed below. Saturday night is our famous **Dinner Challenge!** End Saturday relaxing at our roaring all camp campfire with songs and skits. Awards and recognition will occur on Sunday morning.

Things to keep in mind: Troops bring **ALL** of the equipment necessary for primitive troop camping and will be cooking all their own meals. Campsites are in an open, grassy, tree-less, bumpy meadow. Site sizes are approximately the size of a two-car garage (considerations will be taken given State Mandates and group sizes). Water, outhouses, and handwashing stations are provided. Troops carry their gear from a staging area to their site (about the length of a football field). *The Troop Preparation Packet* is sent upon registration to guide your training and planning.

How Many Scouts can come?

Register as a troop or form your own group with registered Girl Scouts from Multiple Troops. Each troop can have 2-8 members with a 2-adult requirement. To include more troops, we have a limit of one group per troop. (*After Dec 15, 2022, and dependent on space availability, registration opens to troops/groups from any Girl Scout council and additional groups from the same troop*)

And the Challenges for 2023 are....

All challenges include the respective GSWW Volunteer Essentials and Safety Activity Checkpoints.

- **Fire Building:** With your ten essentials packed, show us your campfire skills to accomplish a task.
- **Team Dynamics:** Your positive & cooperative teamwork skills will lead you to success.
- Plants, Shelters, & Knots: Show us how to survive an unplanned overnight in the woods.
- ❖ First Aid: Test your knowledge of treating outdoor ailments.
- **Campsite Maintenance**: Demonstrate how well you establish & keep a 'good' safe campsite.
- ❖ Challenge Dinner: Prepare a creative & nutritious dinner with surprise ingredients (revealed to only the Cadette troops upon arrival Friday). All prep & cooking is done without leaders present.
- **Leader's Challenge:** Paperwork timeliness & accuracy, skillful mentoring, and letting go will help set your troop up for a successful experience.

- \$35 per person

Key Dates:

November 1st, 2022: Registration opens (registrations received prior to this date will be thrown into a basket and randomly drawn for processing)

March 31st, 2023: Final payment MUST be postmarked by this date.

March 31st, 2023: Registration closes

Registration information:

- **Adults:** Minimum and maximum are two per troop.
- **Troop Members:** Minimum of 2 and the maximum is 8.
- **Total Participants:** Minimum of 8 troops or 50 scouts, max is 20 troops.

- Registration will be acknowledged by email from the Cascade Challenge Committee Registrar and sent to both advisors and will include the Challenge Troop Preparation Packet.
- Cancellations received after March 31st, 2023, will forfeit their deposit.
- If the final payment is not postmarked by 3/31/2023 the registration for your troop is cancelled, your spot will be offered to a waitlisted troop and your deposit will not be returned.
- Waitlisted troops (that are not placed) will receive their deposits back after the event takes place.
- The Leader's Challenge begins with the thorough, legible, and accurate completion of this registration form ©
- Troops requesting vegetarian & medically necessary gluten free food will receive such option for the entire troop.
- Leaders in gluten-free or vegetarian troops will be placed with a different troop with the same food restrictions for dinner challenge.
